Texas public schools consist of more than 1,200 school districts and charters, 8,000 campuses, and nearly 4.6 million students who are primarily Hispanic (46%) and White (36%). More than half of the students are economically disadvantaged and 16% are limited English proficient. These students are served by over 300,000 teachers who earn an average of \$46,000 annually.


