The Texas public school system consists of 1,237 school districts and charters, 8,435 campuses, and over 4.8 million students. Students are primarily Hispanic (49%) and White (33%). More than half are economically disadvantaged and 17% are limited English proficient. Texas public school students are taught by 333,000 teachers who earn an average of \$49,544 annually.
